

MINUTES

of the Meeting of Occold Parish Council held at 8pm on Monday 12th June 2006 at The Beeches

The meeting had been called to discuss a planning application

2. **PA0836/06/FUL Guest annexe...; White House Farm, Dublin Road, Occold**

The plans were tabled and discussed. Although not clearly stated in the application papers the proposal concerns the conversion and extension of an existing outbuilding, which is currently in a poor state of repair. Councillors were of the opinion that the development would be an improvement to the existing building. It was noted that there were to be no windows on the rear elevation, which forms the boundary with the neighbouring property. There was some speculation as to whether the annexe was to be used for holiday rental, but it was not felt that this would be a reason to object to the proposal in any case

Mr Hull proposed and Mr Warnes seconded recommending approval. All in favour
