

MINUTES

of the Meeting of Occold Parish Council held at 8pm on Monday 27th March 2006 at The Beeches

Present: Mr K Chittock, Mr A Andrews, Mr S Hubner, Mr B Hull, Mr B Mann, Mr R Owen, Mr M Underwood, Mr S Warnes.

The meeting had been called to discuss two planning applications

1. Apologies had been received from Mrs Careford

2. PA 323/06 Change Rooflight to Cover Tool Storage Area; 20 Ash Tree Close, Occold

The application was an amendment to PA599/03 granted in July 2003. The title should refer to the *roofline* not rooflight. The proposed changes to add doors and change the roofline would not affect any neighbours as they were on the side of the house facing into the garden. Mr Hubner proposed and Mr Underwood seconded recommending approval. All in favour

3. 453/06/LBC Conversion of Outbuildings for Domestic Use; Grove Farm, Bulls Hall Road, Occold

The proposal was to convert part of a range of outbuildings to a children's room. The outward changes would result in a semi-glazed door and a window replacing existing wooden doors. Mr Owen proposed and Mr Hull seconded recommending approval. All in favour

4. Matters to be advised (at the Chairman's discretion)

4(1) Mr Hull asked if there had been any response to our request for the dog waste bin to be emptied more frequently. He was not sure if there was still a problem. The Clerk had reported via Customer Service Direct and would now chase up to see what had happened

4(2) The Chairman reported that a parishioner had volunteered to act as a lollipop man (now called a crossing attendant). Clerk to find out procedure for having one in the village – contact Education Department?

4(3) The Clerk reported that the planning permission for the new village hall plans had been granted

4(4) Mr Underwood reported that some tyres had been dumped in the right-hand ditch alongside Bulls Hall Road, beyond the council houses. Clerk to report to MSDC waste team to get them removed but this might be a problem as the ditches are usually held to be the responsibility of the landowner
